A superb aggressive batsman with the highest score of 136, Ray was no slouch with the ball, taking 6/28 in a second eleven game.

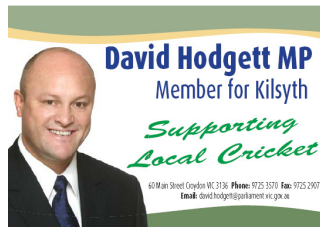
I was lucky enough to have a great chat with Ray at last season's heritage day and he was a great help; offering many stories and a picture of the 2nd Eleven premiership team.

(Golf can be organised if we have the numbers interested in playing)

I need to know numbers by the 5th December 2009 so I can book accommodation and activities for the event.

It will be up to every person to organise or run raffles or fundraising for the trip in coordination with the club.

We have 3 travel arrangements available if you are interested

- 1) **Bus** leaving at 3:00 pm on Thursday 25th March 2010, bus must arrive back to Melbourne no later than 2:30pm Sunday 28th March. This will be a little more expensive, longer to get there. But we will have the use of a bus to go to local football, races etc.
- 2) Travel by **Train**- leave 8:30 am Thursday 25th March 2010 Southern Cross Station arrive Albury approx 12 Midday, bar on train opens at 10:30 am. Leave Sunday 28th March @ 4pm arrive back in Melbourne 7:00pm approx. This is a cheaper option but will not have access to a bus and will have to use a cab or walk to the races local footy etc.
- 3) **Make your own way there.** You will be able to arrive and leave when you like and only have to pay for accommodation and the races/ local footy events.

If it is viable we will be able to organise all three travel arrangements to attend but would need at least 20 people for the bus trip.

If you are going to attend, see Christian **ASAP**. You will need to pay a \$50 deposit to secure your spot.

If minimum numbers are not confirmed by the 5th December the trip will be cancelled.
