And so now we are ready for Round 1, that commences this weekend for our Juniors and Seniors...I can't wait.

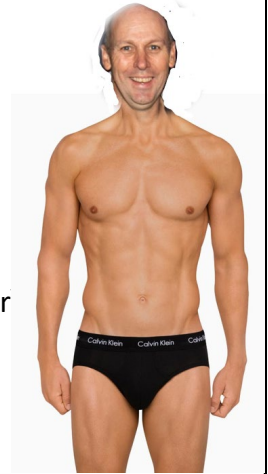
